



## Admissions Guidelines: Saskatchewan

### General admission guidelines applicable to all programs:

- Grade 12 English Language Arts A30 and B30
- Four additional Grade 12 courses
- Minimum overall average of 70% (75% required for Biology or Kinesiology)

### Specific program admission guidelines:

- **Applied Science (Engineering)** – Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in both. Physics 30 is recommended.
- **Biology** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in Chemistry.
- **Business Administration** – English 30 with a minimum 70% and Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30.
- **Chemistry** – Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in both.
- **Community Development** - Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30.
- **Computer Science** – Precalculus 30 with a minimum grade of 60% (applicants with only Foundations of Mathematics 30 will be required to successfully complete the non-credit Math 0120 Advanced Pre-University Mathematics in the first semester of the program).
- **Economics** – Bachelor of Arts - Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30. Bachelor of Science – Precalculus 30 with a minimum grade of 60%.
- **Environmental Geoscience** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in Chemistry.
- **Environmental Science** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in Chemistry.
- **Geology** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in Chemistry.
- **Kinesiology** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30.
- **Mathematics** – Precalculus 30 with a minimum 70%.
- **Music** – All prospective music students will complete a School of Music application. For students interested in the Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Music Therapy degrees, a live (or recorded) audition is required with the application.
- **Nutrition** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30 and Chemistry 30. A minimum grade of 60% is required in Chemistry.
- **Physics** – Precalculus 30 with a minimum grade of 60%. Physics 30 recommended.
- **Psychology** – Foundations of Math 30 or Precalculus 30.

### High school transcript self-report of grades:

- Students have the opportunity to self-report their transcript information, which Acadia will use to assess admission to degree programs. High school applicants must report all academic Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses along with all available midyear or final grades. Information provided will be automatically assessed and applicants will be advised of their admissibility to Acadia.
- Offers of admission based on self-reported transcript information will be verified with the final official transcript from your high school or provincial Ministry of Education. You should arrange for your final transcript to be sent to Acadia at the end of June. All applicants must have self-reported their course information accurately and must maintain their academic admission average in their final results; otherwise the offer of admission may be withdrawn.

### Early fall admission:

Students may be considered for early fall admission before their first set of Grade 12 marks is available. Students applying for early fall admission should include their final Grade 11 marks and a school-approved list of courses they are taking in Grade 12 (both semesters) with their application. Grade 12 courses must be consistent with the guidelines listed above.

### Entrance Scholarships:

An admission application and all required supporting documents for admission must be received in the Admissions Office before March 1 in order to be considered for an entrance scholarship.
